2021-22 Registration Fee Reminder

We hoped to have Registration Fee payments complete by December 1, but there are still many outstanding payments. We are asking each family to contribute a \$100 registration fee for the 2021-22 school year to help offset the operating expenses and support that the GJF provides the Jazz program (sliding scale payment options are available). As described in the October 28th GJF email to families, this fee will not cover 50% of the GJF operating expenses, but there are too many uncertainties with regards to what the rest of the year will look like to warrant a higher registration fee at this time.
